Oxford Houses are self-run, self-supporting addiction recovery homes for individuals who have stopped using alcohol and drugs, hoping for a second chance in life. The first Oxford House opened in 1975 and has since grown to over 3000 houses in the US. All of our houses are gender specific, which includes men's houses, women's house's and houses for women with children. Safe, structured, and supportive environments help to create an atmosphere of growth, responsibility, and self-efficacy.
